The Veteran B.A.R. Championship - Held annually, the championship is won by the veteran member who returns the highest average speed (on standard) over 25, 50, 100 miles and 12hr. time trials..

The John Bull Challenge Cup has been awarded to the winner of the Veteran B.A.R. Championship since 1990, prior to this the championship was held but no trophy was awarded.

History of the trophy - The John Bull Challenge Cup was originally awarded by the Leicester Rubber Co.Ltd. to the Godiva Harriers for their 50 mile time trial. After the merger of the Godiva R.& P. with the Club in 1967 this trophy was in store and in 1990 it was decided to allocate it for this championship.
